

Mumbai Cricket Association signs up Nuvama Group arm as title sponsor for T20 Mumbai leagues

The Mumbai Cricket Association (MCA) on Tuesday said that it has signed Nuvama Group's wealth management business Nuvama Private as the title sponsor for the T20 Mumbai League 2026 and the inaugural T20 Mumbai Women's League.

The men's and women's tournaments will be held simultaneously at Wankhede Stadium from June 1 to June 13.

The association marks a major commercial milestone for the T20 Mumbai League, which was launched in 2018 and has emerged as a talent development platform for Mumbai cricketers aspiring to break into the IPL and international cricket.
